National Aptitude Test In Architecture (NATA) is compulsory for admission to B.Arch. Candidates having minimum 50% marks in 10+2 (Science, Arts and Commerce Stream) or equivalent examination with mathematics as one of the subjects and 40% marks in NATA only are eligible for admissions to B.Arch Course. Diploma holders in any discipline with 50% aggregate marks and mathematics as one of the Subjects are also eligible.
